By providing T-Archive, Warehouse TERRADA and Seisyou Corporation are willing to be a bridge of the valuable documents and the important cultural properties passing down to the next generations, aiming for the contribution to the development of art and culture.

T-Archive is available for preserving and utilizing the valuable writings such as ancient documents permanently by digitizing without disassembling, managing the data on a cloud, and preserving of the original documents in the most appropriate condition. We offer the one-stop, speedy service at a proper price.



1. Advanced scanning without disassembling

We use and manipulate the overhead scanner developed exclusively for digital archiving of the valuable writings, which is also adopted in the digitizing project at the National Diet Library in Japan. This scanning technology enables to digitize the documents without disassembling or destructing, assuring the highest quality in scanning.

2. The digital archiving system

We provide the digital archiving system which users can operate storing, access, and sharing the digitized data. Featuring the high-resolution enlargement function, the system enables users to configure the browsing layers according to the situation, such as easy-browsing via online confidentially within a company or being available to the public.

3. Preserving the original documents of valuable writings

Making the use of safekeeping/preserving know-hows, we store the valuable writings safely in the best condition to prevent damage with assured security. Storing documents to our facility make users keep more room in their own place, which leads to utilize their own space.
