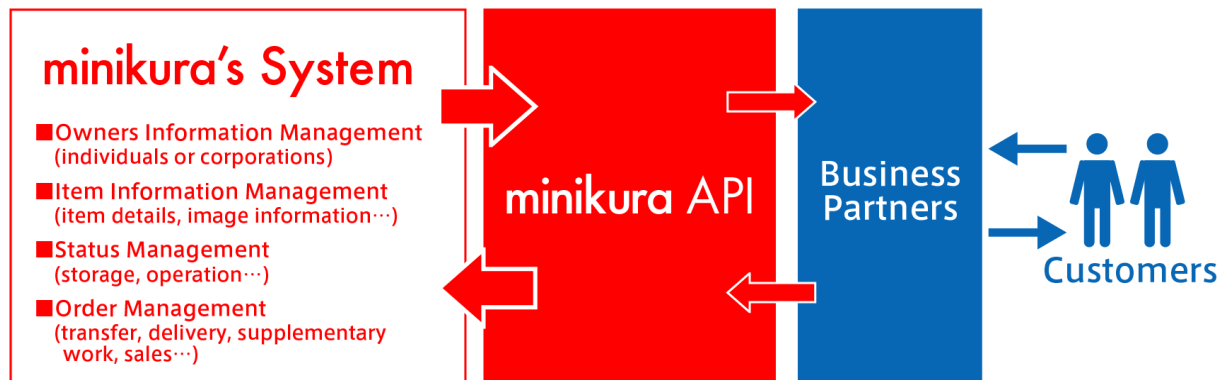


The API of the cloud storage service “minikura” by Warehouse TERRADA has received a patent

"minikura" is operated by Warehouse TERRADA, and is the first storage service in this industry that incorporates the storage and online services. The only thing that clients have to do is to pack items to a specialized ("minikura" original) box and send it to us. The shipping fee is free. Our staff will take photographs of each item with the utmost care, so it would be possible to manage the items visually with ease online. Dry cleaning for clothes is also available as an optional service. The items can be listed on "Yahoo! Auction" and posted to the community site simply. Also, "minikura API," a logistic support, is provided to various companies. And what is more, Warehouse TERRADA is actively supporting startup companies and invested to Air Closet Inc., VONOVO inc., ART STAND Co., Ltd., and Sumally.
