“hinata trunk!” is the smart trunk box service that enables people to go camping with no luggage by depositing camping and outdoor equipment, and MINIKURA provided the operation system to make it possible.

“hinata trunk!” is the smart trunk box service by vivit,inc. that enables to go camping without taking heavy luggage from home by depositing camping and outdoor equipment. The monthly storage fee is 980 yen (plus tax), and users can store their outdoor gear in “hinata trunk!” storage and pick them up only when they need them. All users have to do is to buy a “hinata trunk!” special box, pack their outdoor gear in the box and send it to the storage, which means users can send whatever, whenever, and wherever they like. After using the equipment, they can simply send it back to the storage. Casual camping with no hassle is guaranteed.
