

Pop-up Exhibition by Warehouse TERRADA's ARCHI-DEPOT Museum

- The exhibition of architectural models by leading architects in Japan -

ARCHI-DEPOT Museum, operated by Warehouse TERRADA, will hold the pop-up exhibition "ARCHI-DEPOT Museum Collection Exhibition" at B&C HALL in Tennoz, Tokyo from March 3rd (Sat.).

ARCHI-DEPOT Museum opened in June 2016 as the only museum in Japan specializing in architectural models, and has received more than 80,000 visitors. It is currently closed for renovations to expand its exhibition space, and will reopen to the public in spring.

The pop-up exhibition was planned to offer opportunities to become familiar with architectural models while ARCHI-DEPOT Museum is closed for renovation. The selected models for this exhibition were created by leading architects in Japan, and held in our ARCHI-DEPOT Museum. Focusing on models built or unbuilt between the 1970's to the present, there will be a variety of valuable architectural models including "ROTUNDA" and "Japan Cultural Hall, Paris" by Riken Yamamoto, and "Model of Gehry Residence (1979) for an exhibition" by Tsuyoshi Tane, which is scheduled to be returned to his studio in Paris.

ARCHI-DEPOT Museum will provide information related to its reopening this spring.
