This service "Ten-year Aging" includes "Château Cos d' Estournel," a Bordeaux wine ideal for long aging and its decade of storage in our online wine storage TERRADA WINE STORAGE.

Warehouse TERRADA hosted a Bordeaux Primeur wine tasting event in July 2017, and Château Cos d' Estournel was the most popular among the guests. Château Cos d' Estournel is believed to be promising for the future, and its value is expected to increase for its rarity. The combination of this wine and its storage fee for decade in our TERRADA WINE STORAGE enables to store wine in the optimal environment and deliver it to any place in ten years. Comment :

It has a perfect balance between mellowness and sensitiveness. Though it took time to exhibit its original features in primeur tasting since it was in the middle of its aging process, it expressed its high quality. Every time the wine breathes, its true value is brought out. In fully ripened black berries aroma, there seem nuances of oriental spices, and the taste is sophisticated and elegant. Tannin smooth like silk and long lingering are regarded as its character. The 2016 vintage is wine with great potential for very long aging.

It is a next generational wine cellar, which is integrated an actual storage in an optimal environment and an

online system to manage customers' stored wine collection with their computer or smartphone. Its minimum

monthly storage fee is 90 yen (before tax) per 750 ml bottle. As the stable environment, the best

temperature and humidity for wine aging (14°C±1°C / 70%±10%), and a reliable security (24-hour

surveillance camera, and earthquake-resistant) are guaranteed. After the wines are sent to our cellar, they

are examined and photographed, the detailed information is registered, and then an original wine note

exclusive for each customer is prepared online without any request or setting. The wines are able to be sent

from customers' home, specialty wine stores, or online shops to our cellar, and the stored wines are able to

be delivered after the application procedure is completed online. Also, the same day delivery service is

launched in some area in Tokyo and Kanagawa. Addition to this, for customers who stores 3,000 bottles or

more to TERRADA WINE STORAGE, the TENNOZ PREMIUM OPTION service is offered to support to enrich

wine collection.

Since the foundation in 1950, Warehouse TERRADA has been cultivating better storage techniques and

making proactive action on the capital investment in order to store and preserve items under the best

environment. Expanding our business beyond the traditional warehousing, we are currently pursuing the

preservation and restoration technique to raise the value of stored items and pass it on to the next

generations. We are also developing a business to create a hub to output the new culture by making a full

use of our knowledge as a professional in space creation.

We have started rental wine cellars since 1970s and kept improving facilities to meet the world standard of

storage environment with the temperature of keeping 14°C±1°C and humidity at 70%±10%, which have

been receiving high acclaims in the industry. Now we have wine cellars in four locations around Tokyo

(Shinagawa, Setagayadaita, Futakotamagawa, Tsuzuki-Shinishikawa), and those spaces have the same

potential environment as underground wine caves at wineries. We also have an online service, CLOUD WINE

CELLAR (https://cloudwinecellar.com/en/), that enables owners to take their wine into their cellar from one

bottle.
